### **Individual Adult**

**\$ 75**

*Individual adult registration affords the member full rights and privileges, including attendance at convention and voting rights in organizational elections.*

### **Job Fair Auditions**

**\$ 15**

*Individuals interested in participating in the Job Fair. This registration is to present your audition or tech materials for professional work to a number of attending companies and organizations across the region. This fee also grants access to certain workshops while at GTC.*

### **High School Student**

**\$ 45**

*High school student registration includes attendance at the convention, participation in college placement auditions and festivals, but does not include voting rights. All high school students pay this fee, so festival participants will not be charged an additional festival fee.*

### **Festival Entry (Primary Organizational Membership)**

**\$ 160**

*Festival Entry registration includes membership and registration for the director of the festival play, plus a festival participation fee. The director is a full member of the organization with voting rights. This registration applies to all play festivals at Georgia Theatre Conference, including the Community Theatre Festival, the Middle School Theatre Festival, the Ray Horne Secondary School Festival, the R. Lynne Woody Secondary School Festival, and the Theatre for Youth Festival.*

### **New Play Competition Entry**

*The Georgia Theatre Conference, the official theatre organization for the state of Georgia, is taking submissions for its annual One Act New Play Competition through June 30, 2024. The competition is open to writers currently residing in Georgia. The winning playwright will receive a \$500 prize, a play lab at the conference, and a performance as a staged reading during the conference, tentatively scheduled October 16-19, 2024 at the 60<sup>th</sup> Annual Georgia Theatre Conference Convention held in Gainesville, GA.*

## **Play Festival Participants**

*Cost varies - See information below*

*Play Festival Participant registration is required for each member of the cast and crew in a registered festival production. The cost of the festival participant fee varies according to the festival in which the registrant is participating.*

<b>Middle School Festival Participants (Grades 5-8)</b>	<b>\$ 15 each</b>
<b>Ray Horne Festival Participants (High School Registration)</b>	<b>\$ 45 each</b>
<b>R. Lynn Wooddy Festival Participants (High School Registration)</b>	<b>\$ 45 each</b>
<b>Theatre for Youth Festival</b>	<b>No Additional Fee*</b>

*It is important to remember that each member of the production team - cast and crew - is to pay the Festival Participant fee.*

*\*In support of the mission of the Georgia Theatre Conference, the Board of Directors have never charged participants in the Theatre for Youth Festival a participation fee.*

## **Individual Event Festival Participants**

**\$ 10**

*Individual Event Festival Participation is an add-on activity that is available to any registered convention attendee. Additional information can be found on the Community Theatre Division webpage.*

## **College Exhibitors (Primary Organizational Membership)**

**\$ 160**

*College Exhibitor Registration includes membership for one representative, plus convention registration and an organizational membership which includes a six-foot table and power in the convention exhibit hall, and access to our college placement auditions. A registered college exhibitor has full voting rights in the organization, and can hold office.*

## **Business Exhibitors**

**\$ 125**

*Business Exhibitor registration includes a six-foot table and power in the convention exhibit hall. Business exhibitors are not members of the organization, do not have voting rights, and do not have access to convention activities.*

## **Chaperones**

*(Cost varies - See information below)*

*Chaperone Registration is available for middle and high schools whose administration requires additional adult supervision on school trips. Chaperones will have limited access to convention activities based upon seating capacity, the festival in which the school is participating, and other concerns.*

**Secondary School Chaperones \$ 30 each**

**Middle School Chaperones \$ 15 each**

*Important: Chaperones who want full access to the convention, voting rights, and eligibility to hold office must register as Individual Members.*

<b>Organizational Membership (Primary Member)</b>	<b>\$ 160</b>
<b>Organizational Membership (Affiliate Member)</b>	<b>\$ 25</b>

*Organization Membership is required for:*

- *Schools and Community Theatres that wish to participate in a play festival;*
- *Colleges and Universities that wish to participate in Secondary School & Transfer Auditions*
- *Professional and/or commercial companies that wish to screen, interview and/or hire at the Job Fair & Professional Auditions*

*Primary Organizational Membership includes convention registration and membership for one representative, and participation in any one of the following designated activities:*

- *Screening access to the Georgia Theatre Conference Secondary School and Transfer Auditions*
- *Performing company in the Community Theatre Play Festival*
- *Screening and Hiring Access to the Georgia Theatre Conference Job Fair & Professional Auditions*
- *Performing Company in the Middle School Play Festival*
- *Performing Company in the R. Lynn Woody Play Festival*
- *Performing Company in the Ray Horne Play Festival*

*Primary Organizational Membership for College/University and Professional or Commercial companies also includes a six-foot table in the convention exhibit area.*

*Affiliate Organizational Membership is available at a rate of \$25 for each additional faculty or staff member from any company or organization that holds Primary Organizational Membership provided that the Affiliate member presents a minimum of two workshop sessions at convention.*

- *The sessions may be two offerings of the same workshop, or two different workshops.*
- *To qualify, potential Affiliate Members must submit workshop proposals by the published deadline for proposals.*
- *Affiliate members may participate in the Primary member's designated activity.*
- *Affiliate membership is NOT available to individual festival participants.*

*Both Primary and Affiliate Organizational Members have full voting rights in the organization and are eligible to hold office.*

## **Lifetime Membership** **\$ 260**

*Lifetime Membership in the Georgia Theatre Conference is currently \$260. Lifetime members receive a discount of \$45 off their annual convention registration.*

### **Festival Entry** *(Primary Organizational Membership)*

**\$ 160**
